History

Sandstone Health Care Center is owned by Tom Opatz and Fred Struzyk who have health care facilities in Watkins, St. Joseph and Shell Lake, Wisconsin. Tom and Fred began operating rural senior care facilities with the purchase of the Watkins Hilltop Nursing Home in 2012.

In May 2017 Tom and Fred bought the hospital and nursing home facility from the North Pine Area Hospital District. On May 17 Sandstone Health Care Center transitioned the skilled nursing services from Essentia Health to its operation. Tom is the administrator of the Sandstone Health Care Center.

It is the only skilled nursing home in central and northern Pine County and is wound care certified.

Amenities

Transitioning from the Essentia nursing home to the new management was seamless with most of the existing, excellent staff staying on board. Many residents chose to stay at the facility and continue enjoying the excellent care. The caring, gentle manner of all the staff makes all residents feel at home and safe.
